Instruction will focus on all the basic lists of Danzan Ryu Jujitsu. However, this year's Seminar will also include classes in Iaido, Kenjitsu, Brazilian Jujitsu as well as Capoeira. Although some classes will be restricted by AJJF rank, every session will have at least one class suitable for beginners.

The cost for the weekend will be \$100 for the entire weekend, \$65 for a single day. **American Judo & Jujitsu Federation membership is required for all participants.** Applications will be available at the door at the rate of \$60 annual dues or \$5 for an event membership. The weekend's registration fee will include lunches (vegetarian and others) for both Saturday and Sunday. Saturday evening the group will gather together at a local Chinese restaurant for dinner at a cost of around \$12 - \$15 per person.
