The banquet will cost \$14.00 for adults and \$6 for children under 10.

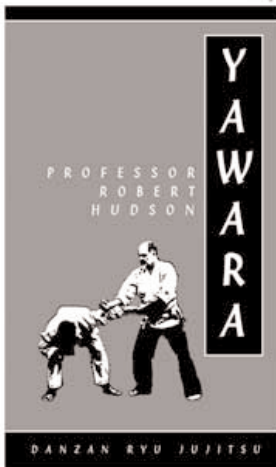
The healing art classes will qualify for continuing education for licensure.
