

AJFF Juniors' Scholarship
DESCRIPTION

Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance for AJFF Junior Registrants, age 15 or under, wishing to attend an AJFF sanctioned event for which they might be otherwise unable due to financial hardship.

Eligibility

Applicants must be age 15 or under as of the date of the event.

Applicant eligibility will be determined by the application submitted and the Sensei recommendation.

Funding

The AJFF Juniors' Scholarship is funded through targeted donations made to this fund.

Funding requests will be made by the parent or guardian on behalf of the applicant, age 15 or under.

The award amount may cover all or part of the cost of the event and is partially based on the money available.

Awarding of the scholarship is for all or part of the cost of the event.

Exclusions from this award may be, but not limited to: travel, housing, material fees, equipment.

Requests should be submitted at least 45 days prior to the planned event. A waiver for the deadline may be considered in special circumstances.

Review Process

The applicant, applicant's parent or guardian and Sensei complete their portions of the application and send it to the Event Host.

The Event Host will submit the Application to the AJFF Manager of Finance finance@ajjf.org

Requests are reviewed by a committee made up of the AJFF Manager of Finance and the AJFF Treasurer.

A member of the committee may contact the applicant for additional information.

The committee will notify the Event Host about the decision to award the scholarship. When approved, the award will be sent to the Event Host.

Disbursement Process

After the event, but within 90 days of the completion of the event, the Event Host sends a reimbursement request to the AJFF Manager of Finance.

Expense reports and any required receipts must be included with the request.
